Reviewer's guidelines

Here are basic guidelines to follow for reviewer participating in peer review of the articles submitted for The Bhutan Journal.

- 1) Use formal language and complete sentences while providing comments. Avoid excessive uses of the word 'Please."
- 2) Use the guidelines [http://www.bhutanwatch.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/06/Submission-Guidelines.pdf] to check the format of the article and understand the expectation of the journal. However, reviewer need not spend time editing the formats. Technical team will handle it.
- 3) Use track changes to highlight minor mistakes and table below to show major mistakes. Check the grammar (highlight YELLOW), spelling (highlight RED) and the most importantly the context, historical and statistical facts, authenticity of data, references, and citations.
- 4) Use Table 1. to show the areas needing correction and your suggestions.
- 5) In case of the confusion, contact The Bhutan Journal at the email provided below.
